Below is our partial song list. For parties this adds up to about five hours from start to finish which includes roughly three one-hour sets and breaks. We usually start playing about an hour after the party start time as experience shows this makes the biggest impact on your guests. We bring music to play prior to the start of our show and for in between sets of the same genre.

Fee/Gratuity:

Our basic fee covers a 3-piece set-up (2 guitars & congas). Since there are many items that affect the cost such as special requests, driving distance, day of the week and other factors we ask that you call for a price and to check availability. The fee doesn't go down for shorter play times since the set-up and break-down is exactly the same (which is the hard part). Gratuities are completely optional; however, if you have a very good time and want to show your appreciation they'll be accepted as will gifts of small children, cigars and electronics. Also, if we are playing longer than the 5 hours please figure about \$100 per hour (if you want to make that per musician, that's up to you).

We are also available in three and four piece set ups for budget minded and larger venues. Larger shows may warrant adding additional pieces.

Overnight Shows:

When you compare our cost to a DJ it's almost ridiculous what we charge (ridiculously cheap that is), but we enjoy what we do. But, one thing that isn't as much fun is traveling. This adds a whole new dimension because now you have to figure hotel costs, car rental, food, flights, and potentially gear rental depending how far we're traveling. The expenses will vary, so that'll depend on the situation. For the musicians though you can figure \$500 per day per musician. We love to play the far away shows, so we're not trying to turn you off....we just want you to know what you should expect.

Expectations:

We are musicians so you can expect us to drink your booze, eat your food and take your women, but don't worry we don't drink much. You can also expect to have a good time – although some people we just can't help. Also,

please make sure that the venue realizes that we are “guests” at your party and not “contractors.”
